 - The bodyguards advice about waters temperature
 - Echo near a cliff
 - Working day finishes at the canning factory

VERBAL/LINGUISTIC

1. Visit the Eco-museum of Artea (<u>http://www.artea-udala.org/</u>) and ask the guides there about the biggest changes on the Basque landscape in the last fifty years.

INTRAPERSONAL INTELLIGENCE

1. Pupils have do a personal research about the main dangers that threaten our woods (pollution, fires, foreign species, desertification...)and expose the conclusions in class.
